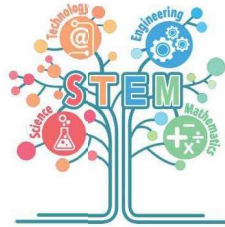
Important Information

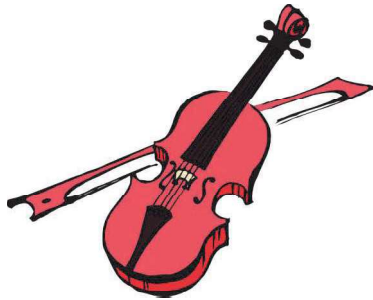
